On Thursday, 15 August 2024, the 503 Task Forces, especially the Soldiers of the Quarry Bawah Post led by Second Lieutenant Febri, carried out a security patrol in the Delpel Village, Kenyam District. Team met a child named Daniel Murib, who had injured his leg due to falling while playing football with his friends.

Luckily, while carrying out the patrol, a Medical personnel from the Task Force was also part of the Patrol Team. Seeing Daniel's condition, the personnel immediately checked and treated Daniel's leg wound. After the treatment, the personnel gave Daniel free medicine to consume for the next few days to heal his wound.
